



**SICT Welcomed New Southeast Asia Service of COSCO and
Expanded Cross-strait Service of China United Lines**

On 27 April, SICT welcomed the maiden call of the Sheng He, the first ship of Cosco's new Southeast Asia Service (HSH). The weekly service includes two 725-TEU container vessels that follow a rotation of Shantou, Hong Kong, Zhanjiang, Singapore, and Ho Chi Minh City.

On the same day, the Fu Chun, the second container vessel in the expanded direct Cross-strait Service (STD) of China United Lines, called at SICT. The 546-TEU vessel calls at SICT every Monday on a rotation of Shantou, Kaohsiung, Yantian, Huangpu, and Shekou. The shipping line has also restructured the route of the Far East Cheer, the first STD vessel. The ship now calls at Shantou every Tuesday and Friday on a port rotation of Shantou, Kaohsiung, Taichung, Shantou, and Shekou.
