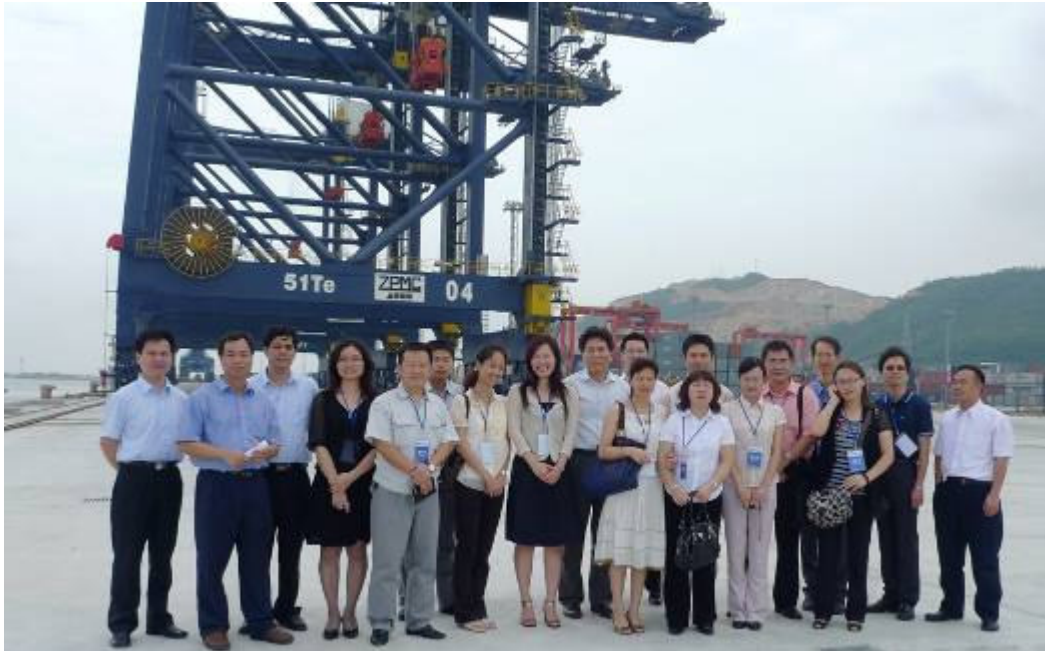
ZICT(G) Welcomes the First Visit of a Local Manufacturing Delegation

[2 June 2009 – Hong Kong] – On 22 May, Zhuhai International Container Terminals (Gaolan) (ZICT(G)) hosted a terminal visit and Q&A forum for representatives of leading makers of electric products and consumer electronics. ZICT(G) is a member of Hutchison Port Holdings (HPH). HPH actively promotes ZICT(G) to international buyers, local shippers, 3PLs and shipping lines. The visit was the first in what will be a series of upcoming tours by representatives of manufacturing industries in Zhuhai, Zhongshan, Jiangmen, Foshan and other areas in ZICT(G)' s hinterland.

This visit included company representatives from Philips, Panasonic, Canon, Brother, Ele-Tech and Mitsumi Electric. Since these multinationals have manufacturing plants in Zhuhai, their representatives were particularly interested in the terminal facilities and services, port and logistics developments as well as customs clearance and declaration.

ZICT(G) has two container berths with the first berth commenced operations in December 2008 and the second berth will be operational in the second half of 2009. As the only deep-water port in the Western Pearl River Delta, ZICT(G) provides a cost-effective and convenient shipping gateway to local manufacturers.
